





900 EAST UVX STATION

Provo — BYU Campus

In spring 2025, UTA will begin construction to install 2 new platforms at 900 East and 1100 North in Provo. These stops will be adjacent to the recently constructed BYU Music building. Looped in with the current stations surrounding the University's campus, these stations will provide more comprehensive access to students, employees, and staff commuting to and from the school. The project is estimated to cost \$4 million with funding from a CMAQ grant through MAG and a CMAQ PM 2.5 grant. BYU will also be donating some land for the stations.

-  Give convenient access to new and existing facilities in the area
-  Provide service to the new BYU Music Building
